

Presentation of the dissertation project

1. CONTENT OF THE PRESENTATION

a. The subject of research given by the topic of the work.

The argument of the topicality of the topic/urgency of solving the problem within:

- the development of the field of study: the shift of theory (the development of a theory that will form the starting point for solving the research problem given by the topic of the work) - **in what is the subject of research original?**
- solutions to the problem in economic practice.

b. The current state of the problem-solving in the national, and international context.

- theoretical framework (original authors of basic theories relevant to solving the problem),
- methodological framework (contemporary authors of research studies published in important scientific journals - methodology and conclusions of studies as a starting point for creating your own research methodology - **in what way is your own research methodology innovative?**

ORIGINAL RESEARCH SUBJECT AND/OR INNOVATIVE RESEARCH METHODOLOGY = SCIENTIFIC VALUE OF THE WORK

c. Objective and research methodology

- The goals of the work (main, partial)
- Research object (**Where, on what basis will I verify the validity of research assumptions?** – research sample, method of its composition, selection criteria, representativeness...).
- Research methods (**the basic research methods, methods of collecting and processing information; information sources...** - in the context to *b*) *The current state of the problem solving* - innovativeness of research methodology, methodological pitfalls...).
- *Research assumptions (either in the form of research questions or hypotheses): **What is the source of the research assumptions?** – theory, partial results, practical problem _ in the context to *b*) *The current state of the problem-solving... VOLUNTARY**

d. Results and discussion

- **Expected theoretical and practical benefits of the dissertation**
 - *What are the expected results of the application part of the work (analysis)?*
 - *How can be the theory developed, and what benefits are significant for the practice?*
