

**International students and lecturers.  
Entry to Slovakia and Accommodating at dormitories  
of Matej Bel University in Banska Bystrica  
in SS 2020/2021.**

Dear international students/lecturers,

We would like to remind you that the condition for accommodating at the student dormitory of Matej Bel University in Banska Bystrica is **to comply fully with the legislation of the Slovak Republic governing the entry into the territory of the Slovak Republic** (195 Decree of the Public Health Office of the Slovak Republic).

Dormitory facilities of Matej Bel University **do not provide the quarantine accommodation**. A student can accommodate at the dormitory **only after meeting the conditions** of entry into the territory of the Slovak Republic. Upon arrival to the dormitory he/she will sign a **solemn declaration** and **prove the negative result** of the **Slovak PCR test** for COVID-19, **not older than 48 hours**.

**Conditions of entry into the territory of the Slovak Republic from 26 April, 2021**

1. those who have visited in the last 14 days **only EU countries, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland or the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland** - **must undergo isolation** at home or in a quarantine facility, which can be finished:
  - o by obtaining a negative PCR test result for COVID-19 disease - testing can be performed **no earlier than on the 8th day of isolation** OR
  - o by **completing 14th day of isolation** without the need for testing if asymptomatic isolation;
2. those who have visited in the last 14 days **other countries than those mentioned above** - **must undergo isolation** at home or in a quarantine facility and **undergo RT-PCR test performed no earlier than on the 8th day of the isolation**. Isolation can be completed **only after receiving a negative test result**. It cannot be terminated without testing and isolation cannot be prevented by submitting a negative test result for COVID-19;

3. those entering Slovakia must **register on the website** <https://korona.gov.sk/en/ehranica/> immediately upon entering Slovakia at the latest; be able to **demonstrate your registration** to a member of the Police Force during your stay in Slovakia; the **obligation to inform your doctor** in Slovakia or the locally competent doctor about the isolation;
4. every person **entering Slovakia by air** is required to **fill in an electronic passenger search form** (Public Health Passenger Locator Form) in connection with the protection of public health:

### Exception for „pendlers“ (commuters) in EU countries, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland or the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

those who have visited in the last 14 days only EU countries, Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein, Switzerland or the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, who have proof of one of the following facts:

- the person has been **vaccinated with a second dose of COVID-19 mRNA vaccine** and more than 14 days have passed since this event;
- the person has been **vaccinated with the first dose of vector vaccine** against COVID-19 and more than 4 weeks have passed since this event,
- **a person 14 days after the first dose of COVID-19 vaccination** (mRNA or vector vaccine), if the first dose of vaccination was given **within 180 days of overcoming COVID-19**, or
- **a person with a certificate of overcoming the COVID-19 disease not older than 180 days.**

THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO THESE PERSONS:

- an **antigen test not older than 48 hours** or a **PCR test not older than 72 hours** upon entry into the territory of the Slovak Republic;
- must **register on the website** <https://korona.gov.sk/en/ehranica/> immediately upon entering Slovakia at the latest;
- must **undergo isolation**, which ends with a **negative result of the RT-PCR test**, which a person **may undergo immediately upon entering Slovakia** at his own expenses;

- if the person does not undergo such an immediate test, he / she will go through the normal registration regime via the e-border form (at the earliest on the 8th day the test, if negative, the isolation ends. Without testing, the asymptomatic isolation lasts 14 days).

Exception for a student without the obligation to complete isolation upon entering Slovakia if:

- a student has a permanent or temporary residence in Slovakia and **attends the school in Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary or Austria** and at the same time can prove it by a school certificate upon entering Slovakia;
- a student has a permanent or temporary residence in Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary or Austria and **attends the school in Slovakia**, which can be proved by a school certificate upon entering Slovakia;
- a student has a permanent or temporary residence in Slovakia and at the same time has the **status of a full-time student who participates in the training process in Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary or Austria**, has not reached the age of 26 and can prove these facts by a confirmation upon entering Slovakia.

We would like to also inform you that in the period **from 12 May to 30 June 2021** an international student may be accommodated in a **dedicated facility of the students dormitories** of Matej Bel University - **in SD 1 (student dormitory 1), Tajovskeho 40, Banska Bystrica**.

In **July and August 2021**, reconstruction work will take place in all areas of the accommodation facilities of Matej Bel University and all rooms **must be vacated**.

Re-accommodation in the student dormitories of Matej Bel University will be possible **from 2 September 2021**.
